Joint Meeting of Unions / Associations in LIC at Bengaluru

The Unions /Associations in LIC met at Bengaluru on 14th May, 2015 to discuss on the issue of wage revision and one more option for pension and decide future course of action.

On behalf of All India Insurance Employees' Association (AIIEA), Com Amanulla Khan, President and Com. V.Ramesh, General Secretary participated.

The meeting was attended by Federation of LIC Class-I Officers' Association, National Organisation of Insurance Officers (NOINO), National Federation of Insurance Field Workers of India(NFIFWI), All India LIC Employees' Federation (AILICEF), National Organisation of Insurance Workers (NOIW), National Organisation of Insurance Workers –BMS (NOIW-BMS), Bharatiya Vima Kamgar Sena (BVKS).

The meeting unanimously condemned the attitude of the LIC management in settling the wage revision to the satisfaction of the employees and officers despite a patient wait of 33 months. The meeting felt that the offer of 12.5% wage increase does not reflect the aspirations of the employees. Therefore, the meeting decided to write a letter jointly signed by the Unions / Associations addressed to the Chairman, LIC to start immediate negotiations leading to a satisfactory wage settlement. The meeting also urged the management to give solution to the long pending issue of One More Option for Pension under 1995 scheme.


Accordingly, a joint letter signed by the Unions /Associations referred above was sent to the Chairman, LIC today. This letter was also signed by All India National Life Insurance Employees' Federation (AINLIEF), All India Life Insurance Employees' Association (AILIEA) who could not attend the meeting at Bengaluru. A copy of the letter is enclosed.

The meeting also discussed the need for agitational programme in the future; the details will be informed soon.

Similar efforts were made in general sector for a joint struggle. The Unions met at Kolkata on 14.5.2015. The decisions will be communicated at the earliest.
