Re:- Joint meeting of Associations working in PSGI Companies at Chennai

A joint meeting of Unions & Associations of Officers & Employees of PSGI Companies was held at Chennai on 18th March, 2017. The meeting was attended by Office Bearers/Representatives of NIAOA, NICOA, UIIOA, OICOA, GIOAIA, AIGIFWA, GIEAIA, AIIEA, NFGIE, AIGISC/STEW Association & AIGISC/STE Parishad (Jayamurthy).

On behalf of AIIEA, Com.K.V.V.S.N.Raju, Vice President, AIIEA, along with Zonal Office Bearers participated in the meeting and Com.K.V.V.S.N.Raju presented our views emphatically and highlighted the need for launching joint struggle in order to thwart the ill- efforts of the Government towards divestment of Four Public Sector General Insurance Companies and realise our long pending justified demands.

A threadbare discussion took place on the status of various issues concerning the Officers and Employees, the most important being another option to join 1995 Pension Scheme. The Associations expressed their serious concern on the Govt.'s decision to offload its stake in the four PSGI Companies, thereby weakening the Public sector character of the Companies and inflicting long term adverse impact on the interests of the policyholders, employees and economy of the country. AIIEA insisted to include scrapping of NPS along with the demand of one more option for pension. The demand for final option for pension can also be oriented as One Pension Scheme for One Industry.

The participants of the Joint meeting unanimously decided to launch intensive struggle against the decision of the Government to list the 4 Public Sector General Insurance Companies and GIC RE in the Stock Exchange and on demand of final option under Pension Scheme,1995.

After weighing out all the options available, the meeting decided to observe the following programmes jointly:-

- ▶ **30th March 2017** -- **Submission of Memorandum to CMD, New India and Lunch hour demonstrations at all Centers.**
- ▶ **7th April 2017** -- **All India Convention at Delhi.**
- ▶ **11th April 2017** -- **Demonstrations during lunch recess at all centres**
- ▶ **26th April 2017** -- **Badge wearing followed by lunch hour demonstrations at all centres.**
- ▶ **3rd May 2017** -- **Dharna in front of four HOs(between 10 am to 1.30 pm)**

Joint Campaign among Employees in all Centers from 1st April to 30th May 2017.

You would be aware that the AIEA has already decided to observe one day strike the day following listing of shares of any Company. The GIEAIA has also decided on the same line. We would try to reach a consensus on this point also in next Joint meeting.

In the mean time, all the Units are requested to implement the above programmes jointly with other Associations with all seriousness and utmost commitment.

A Circular on the above programmes will also be issued on behalf of Joint Forum of Unions and Associations.
