**Re: AIIPA S.L.P.No.019799/2017[Civil]- Supreme Court Proceedings on 26th July, ,2018**

Though originally listed for hearing on July, 24, 2018, our Special Leave Petition along with those of others, was taken up for Hearing on July, 26, 2018 by the Supreme Court No.3 of Justice Madan B Lokur and Justice Deepak Gupta.

When it was the turn of our Senior Counsel Sri. Nag Mohan Das, after arguments by another Senior Counsel of a Petitioner, he placed before the Court that LIC Pension Scheme, 1995 was not under any settlement or agreement and it was introduced by the an executive order of the Central Government; benefits payable to both Pre and post - August 1997, should be uniform and that Hon'ble Delhi High Court had held that there has been discrimination between pre and post-August 1997 pensioners, though the relief granted by the High Court, was not as prayed for by the petitioners.

When the issue of grant of further interim relief was raised by the Sr. Counsel of some other petitioner, the Apex Court desired to know the response of Respondent -LIC. The Advocate on Record, on behalf of LIC, said that the LIC has made calculations and were awaiting clearance from the Central Government, to whom the matter has been referred to and wanted six weeks time. The Hon'ble Supreme Court then directed the LIC Counsel to get instructions and mention the same by Monday, July, 30, 2018 and posted the matter for that day.

All India Insurance Pensioners' Association's [AIIPA] Senior Counsel shall put forth detailed arguments from the next Hearing onwards to protect and further the interests of the LIC Pensioners.
