## Re: Recruitment of Assistants 2019- Issues related to Ex Servicemen

We understand that some serving Defense Personnel who have applied for recruitment to the post of Assistant under Ex Servicemen category are selected in the present round of Assistant recruitment in LIC.

However, these ex-servicemen are encountering some problems. These Defense Personnel have are yet to retire from military services. Some of them are retiring in the near future. They had submitted their applications on the basis of the NOC issued by Defense authorities as per guidelines issued by Director General Resettlement.

As per Notification No. 36034/5/85- Estt (SCT), Government of India, Ministry of Personnel, P.G. and Pensions (Department of Personnel and Training) dated 27<sup>th</sup> October 1986 and Office Memorandum No. 36034/3/91- Estt (SCT) of the said department, dated 3<sup>rd</sup> April 1991, "The persons serving in the Armed Forces of the Union, who on retirement from service, would come under the category of Ex-Servicemen, may be permitted to apply for reemployment ONE YEAR before the completion of the specified term of engagement and avail themselves of all concessions available to ex-servicemen but shall not be permitted to leave the uniform until they complete the specified term of engagement in the Armed Forces of the Union."

In the background of the above provisions of the Government of India, we request you to advise the Divisions to give extension of joining time to such serving Defense Personnel selected in the current round of Recruitment till their final discharge from the Armed Forces.
