Bangalore, all minute details of planning were discussed, to ensure best of convenience and comforts are provided to the senior comrades who will be attending the event so that they are enabled to fully concentrate and actively participate in the proceedings, without any hindrance and contribute for arriving at proper and correct conclusions.

The participants in the meeting were particular to see all aspects of the Conference are considered and ensured, like formation of various committees like Reception Committee, Organizing Committee etc., as the Conference will be a full- fledged one, devoting, discussing and debating on various issues, concerns and problems confronting, not only insurance pensioners, but of the common people at large and the Nation and humanity as a whole.

While understanding and appreciating the feelings and expectations of the comrades, hoping eagerly and expecting anxiously to attend and participate in the Conference, we request all concerned to clearly understand and fully realise that, in view of the prevailing uncertainty posed due to the pandemic situation, certain restraints and constraints are necessary and compelled and forced to observe as we are, as a precautionary and preventive measure, we are to restrict the number of Delegates attending the Conference to 50% (half) of the eligible Delegates.

AIIPA would like to request and reiterate the Pensioners' Associations to strictly follow the advice to restrict and elect ONLY 50% the eligible Delegates. AIIPA Constitution provides, 'one delegate for every block of one hundred members' and NOT PART THEREOF.

While AIIPA feels, Pensioners' Associations with membership of one hundred or less, can elect and send one delegate to ensure their representation in the Conference, others with membership of more than one hundred, should elect only @ one for every block of hundred members and not for fraction of it.

AIIPA would further like to clarify that the AIIPA Office Bearers and Central Committee members can attend the Conference, whether elected or not as a delegate.

AIIPA hopes that all Pensioners' Associations would understand and appreciate the present difficult situation and ensure implementation of these stipulations.
